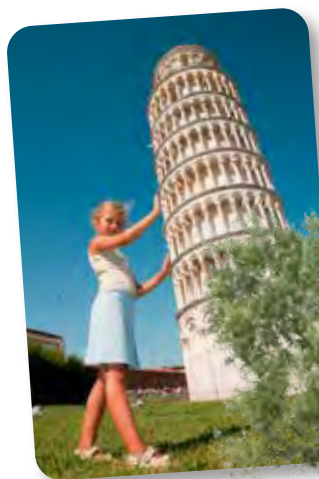


Ciao bella, ciao bello!

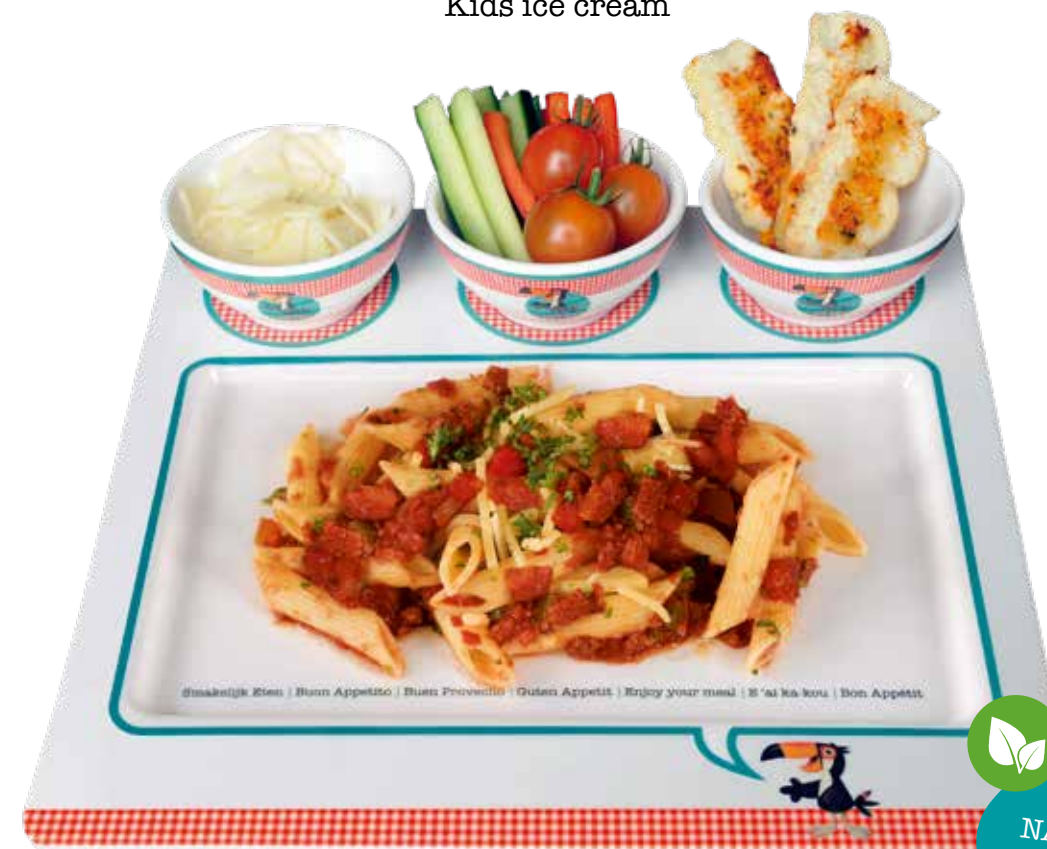

Luck

A typical Turkish souvenir is Nazar Boncugu or the blue eye. It is an 'amulet' of coloured glass and according to Turkish belief, it protects you from harm. You will find them not only in Turkish souvenir shops, but also in taxis and buses and in every Turkish home. Many Turkish people believe that Nazar brings good luck.



Tulips from Amsterdam... or Turkey?

Anyone who thinks tulips are traditionally Dutch is wrong. The truth is, 'our' tulips officially come from Turkey! Turkish traders brought the flowers to the Netherlands in the 16th century. Before long tulips became very popular. In fact, they became so popular that some people paid as much for them as they would for an Amsterdam canal house!

Tea lovers

Turkish men are real tea lovers. They meet in tea houses and often play tavla, a kind of backgammon. Meanwhile, they drink tea with a lot of sugar. Tea houses are the most popular meeting places for men, but you almost never see Turkish women there.



Grand Bazaar

The Grand Bazaar in Istanbul is one of the oldest and largest markets in the world, with an area of 20,000 m², 61 streets and more than 4,000 shops. Here you will find carpets, spices, clothes, and much more. It is really worth a visit if you are in the area. Oh, and don't forget to bargain!!



Snack wisely, eat Turkish delight

You typically eat this sweet treat after a meal or with coffee. The candy consists mostly of sugar, fruit, dates, coconut and nuts and comes in different colors. In Turkey it is called lokum. It comes from the Arabic 'rahat-al-hulkum', which means 'contentment of the throat'.

Döner kebab or shawarma?

Shawarma comes from the word 'çevirme', which means turning. Döner is a Turkish synonym for this. The long skewer with marinated and roasted slices of lamb or other meat is said to have been invented in Turkey. The pieces are thinly sliced and eaten in pita bread.

Holland

Orange

The colour orange is symbolic for the Netherlands. It originates from the name of the royal house ('Van Oranje Nassau'). On King's Day, the whole of the Netherlands is coloured orange, as well as during important sports events such as the European and world football championships.

The world-famous tulips and tulip fields are actually not really Dutch. In fact, the first tulip bulbs came from Turkey.



A traditional Dutch delicacy

These are perhaps the most traditional Dutch cookies we know. It's not only Dutch people who love them, but also foreigners. 'Stroopwafels' have been popular since the day they were invented around 1810. Back then, they were made from old bits of biscuits and some syrup. And because these were not expensive ingredients, they were nicknamed 'cookies for the poor'.



A little bit German

Did you know that the king of the Netherlands, Willem-Alexander, speaks fluent German? Not surprisingly, since he had a German father (Prince Claus), a German grandfather (Prince Bernhard), a German great-grandfather (Prince Hendrik) and a German great-grandmother (Queen Emma).

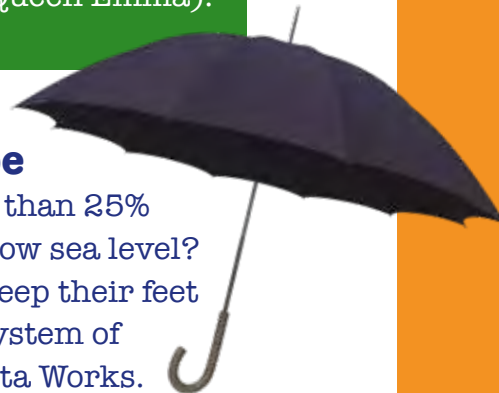
A water landscape

Did you know that more than 25% of the Netherlands is below sea level? Even so, everyone can keep their feet dry thanks to a clever system of dunes, dikes and the Delta Works. Schiphol, Amsterdam's airport, is 4.5 meters below sea level. That is why some passengers find it really exciting to land there.

At last count, there were an estimated 22.7 million bicycles in the Netherlands. That means that the average Dutch person owns 1.3 bicycles. Well, the Dutch do like to go everywhere by bike!

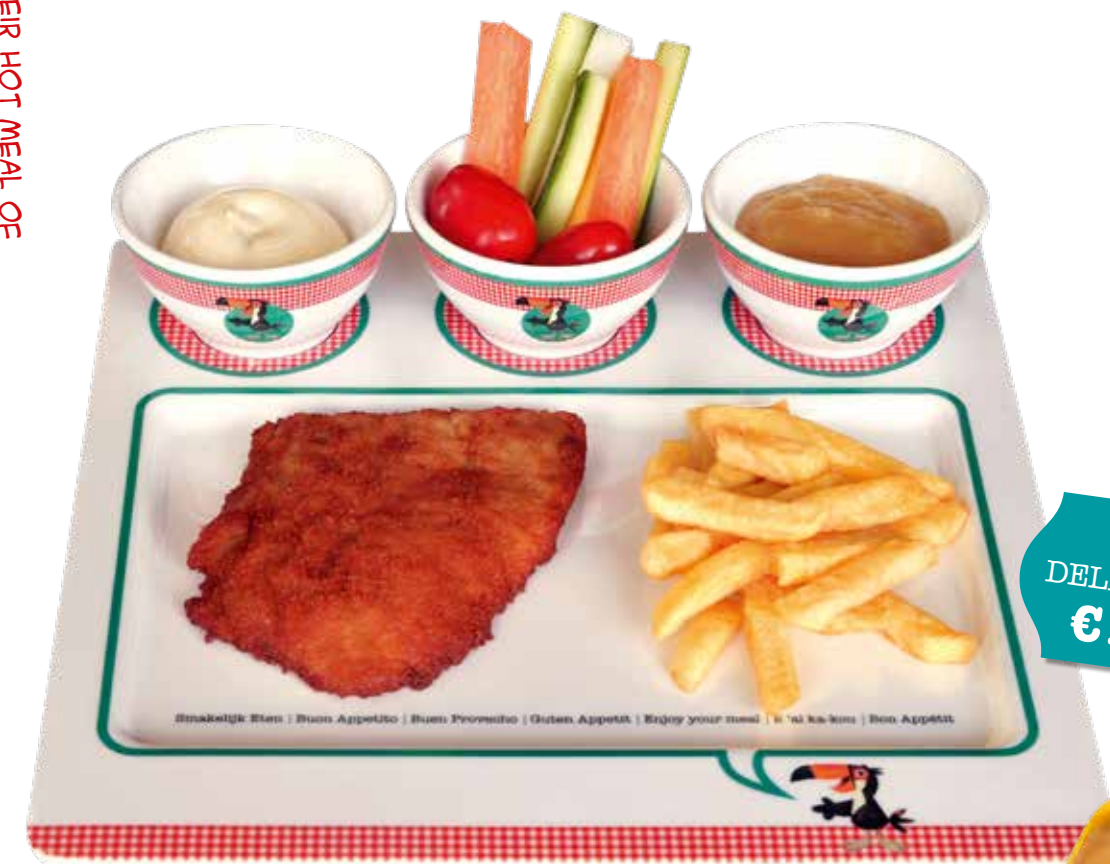

About 400 volcanoes are spread across the archipelago, many of which are still active.



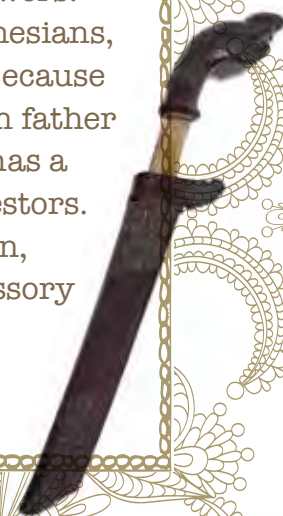

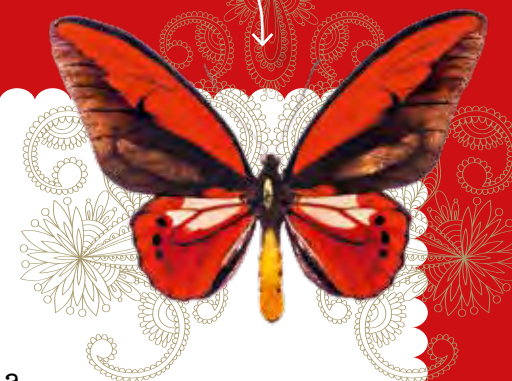

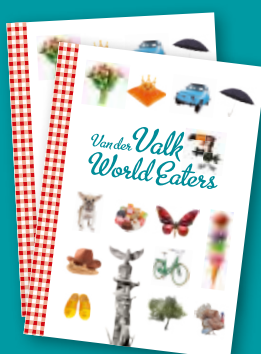
